IDLING LAWS IN CALIFORNIA

Every driver going to or through California should now know about their Idling Laws. The law states

"Idling for more than 5 minutes is prohibited within California's Borders."

So, what can a driver do about cab comfort?

- ◆ Battery Powered Auxiliary Power Systems
- ◆ Fuel-Fired Heaters*
- ◆ Diesel Fueled Auxiliary Power Systems*

◆ Idleaire or similar truck stop infrastructures

What are the violation penalties? Fines start at \$300 and can be as much as \$1,000 per day.

Violators may also face criminal charges.

We hope that everyone is beginning to see the significant amount of money to be saved by using your fuel card to purchase fuel at TA's and Petro's. We took a random group of trucks that have fueled at only TA or Petro from July 1st to July 26th and found the following:

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT DETENTION TIME

- » Detention time is not automatic.
- » Most companies require at least 4 hours before considering payment for detention time.
- » The Shipper/Broker must be notified prior if you think detention is going to occur.
- » Time must be noted on the bills.
- » IF our company is able to collect on detention time—100% is paid to the truck.
